Topic Overview		English	
<p>The Big Idea...</p> <p>Through our topic 'Marvellous Marske, Wonderful Westgarth' we will be exploring our local area and developing our map making skills. Whilst studying the artist Gaudi and his use of mosaics, we will be designing a special area in the Westgarth grounds. Finally, we will be creating some spectacular Christmas Crafts!</p>		<p>As language specialists, we will study the use of settings to create atmosphere and to develop narratives. We will explore senses and how these are reflected in the setting. Following on from that, we will focus upon the features of diaries and letters, using feelings and an extended variety of vocabulary to enhance them. In Grammar, we will be looking at word classification, fronted adverbials and conjunctions, developing these throughout the term and using them in different genres.</p>

<p>As mathematicians, we will continue developing our skills with times tables, diving into the 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables. We will be exploring place value, ensuring the children have a good basis to progress onto further elements. We will also be focusing upon 2 and 3D shapes, moving onto interpreting bar charts and pictograms.</p>		<p>As scientists, we will study the changing seasons, identifying parts and functions of plants and leaves, understanding what is required to sustain life.</p>
