Topic Overview- Magical Worlds		English	
<p>Step into a magical world this term with Year 5 as they head to Hogwarts, Tudor witch trials and distant lands. Through this topic we will discover fantast worlds as well as appreciating the 'magic' that happens in our own world every day.</p>			<p>This term, we will study sections of Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban. We will produce stories and playscripts linked to the Harry Potter books. We will study mythical creatures and their origins, writing information booklets on our chosen creatures.</p>

<p>As mathematicians, we will learn about fractions, decimals and percentages and make links between these. We will find fractions of amounts, compare fractions and learn about how to write equivalent fractions. We will also look at place value within decimal numbers. We will work out how to find percentages of numbers and apply our mathematical learning across the term to problem solving activities.</p>		<p>As scientists, we will discover the magic of forces in our world and how they are used every day. We will study gravity, friction and air resistance, designing and making parachutes. We will also investigate various materials and how some magical mixtures can be made. We will think about reversible and irreversible changes.</p>
