Forte - Loud


Diminuendo - Gradually getting quieter.

Fortissimo - Very loud


Dynamics and markings

Remember dynamic markings are important in music. They give a piece character. You must say at the beginning of a song and throughout what volume to play.

Note values reminder

crescendo (cresc.)

Remember each note has its own special note value. Combining these notes on a stave is how we make songs.

decrescendo (decresc.) or diminuendo (dim.)

Semibreve – 4 beats

Minim – 2 beats

Crotchet – 1 beat

Quaver – ½ beat

Semiquaver – ¼ beat
