

Wraparound Care Parental Agreement

By booking your child into Breakfast Wraparound/After School Wraparound Club, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions.

General

- 1) I have carefully read the school policies for Breakfast Wraparound/Afterschool Wraparound Club. The policies can be found at <https://www.westgarthprimaryschool.co.uk/policies-and-documents/>
- 2) I will contact the school office with any queries/amendments/cancellations and I understand that failure to do so will result in a charge for pre-booked places.
- 3) If my child is absent from school, I will inform the school office if they were due at Breakfast Wraparound or After School Wraparound Club. I understand that failure to do so will result in a charge for pre-booked places.
- 4) I will ensure the school office is informed before 4pm of any change to the usual collection arrangements.

Expectations

- 1) My child will be expected to play safely and within boundaries advised by staff and the school Behaviour policy. Should my child repeatedly behave in an inappropriate manner I accept that I may be asked to collect my child from the club.
- 2) If there is a continuation of repeated unacceptable behaviour, my child may not be able to attend the club. This is at the discretion of the Headteacher.
- 3) Should any issues arise I agree to meet and discuss them with a member of the Wraparound Care team and a member of the Senior Leadership Team at a mutually convenient time.
- 4) I will collect my child from After School Wraparound Club by 5.45pm.

Medical

- 1) In the case of an emergency, if neither parent is contactable, I agree to my child receiving medication, emergency dental, medical or surgical treatment, including anaesthetic or blood transfusion, as considered necessary by the medical authorities present.
- 2) I will update Arbor with any medical information, including GP practice, medical conditions, food allergies and intolerances.
- 3) If my Key Stage 2 child attends Breakfast Wraparound or After School Wraparound Club, and they use an inhaler in school, I will ensure that I provide an additional inhaler to be kept in the Wraparound Club in the KS1 building.
